

Absentee Ballot Application Instructions
2017

1. Place completed application in an addressed envelope and mail or return in person to:

Library Clerk, Administrative Office
Manhasset Public Library
30 Onderdonk Avenue
Manhasset, NY 11030

It must not be returned to the schools

2. All applications must be approved by the Library Clerk (Director).
3. On Friday, March 17 the absentee ballots will be available for approved applications. Patrons can pick up their ballot at the Library Administrative office or have it mailed to them.

Please indicate your preference when returning the application

Note:

If the ballot will be mailed, the completed application must be received by the Library Clerk (Director) by 5 pm on Wednesday, March 29. If the ballot is to be delivered personally (handed) to the voter, the completed application must be received by the Library Clerk (Director) no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, April 4.

All absentee ballots must be received by the Library Administrative Office no later than 5:00 pm Wednesday, April 5. Any absentee ballots received after that time will not be counted.

By Friday, March 31, a voter must be:

1. A citizen of the US
2. 18 years of age
3. A resident of the Manhasset School District for 30 days prior to the vote
4. Registered (Nassau County or School District)
