Common Name	Description	Germination	When to Plant
Apple <i>Malus</i>	Tree, 26'	2-3 Days	Outdoors: Early Spring after a few months of chill
Blueberry <i>Vaccinium sect. Cyanococcus</i>	Perennial, 3-4'	4-8 Weeks	Indoors: In January or February
Cantaloupe <i>Cucumis melo var. cantalupensis</i>	Annual vine, 1'	7-10 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost
Cherry <i>Prunus avium</i>	Tree, 12-25'	2 Weeks	Chill 1 to 2 months sow in the ground in Spring.
Elderberry <i>Sambucus</i>	Woody perennial, 6-9'	Several months	Best in fall or early winter
Honeydew <i>Cucumis melo var. inodorous</i>	Annual vine 24-36"	7-14 Days	Direct sow 3-4 weeks before last frost
Lemon <i>Citrus limon</i>	Perennial, 6-8'	2-3 Weeks	Best to sow seeds as soon as possible
Melon <i>Cucumis melo</i>	Annual, 24" across	5-10 Days	Indoors: 2-4 weeks before last frost
Mulberry <i>Morus</i>	Tree, 20-30'	14 Days	Indoors: in Spring or Fall
Orange <i>Citrus × sinensis</i>	Tree, up to 32'	3 Days	Outdoors: 6 weeks after last frost
Pumpkin <i>Cucurbita pepo</i>	Annual vine, 12-60"	10 Days	Indoors: 3-4 weeks before last frost
Raspberry <i>Rubus idaeus</i>	Perennial, 4-5'	11-21 Days	Indoors: in Spring or Fall
Strawberry <i>Fragaria × ananassa</i>	Low growing perennial, 6-12"	1-6 Weeks	Indoors: 8 weeks before last frost
Watermelon <i>Citrullus lanatus</i>	Annual vine, 16-24"	4-12 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost
