Common Name	Description	Germination	When to Plant
Asparagus (<i>Asparagus officinalis</i>)	Perennial, vegetable 4' tall, 2' wide.	14-28 Days	Between February and May
Bean (<i>Phaseolus</i>)	Annual, 2-15' tall, 2-3' wide.	8-10 Days	Indoors: 2-4 weeks before last frost
Beets (<i>Beta Vulgaris</i>)	Annual, 1-2' tall 1-2' wide.	5-12 Days	Indoors: 2-4 weeks before last frost
Broccoli (<i>Brassica Oleracea Var Italia</i>)	Biennial, annual, vegetable, 18-30" and 12-24" wide.	3 Days	Early to Mid-April
Brussel Sprouts (<i>Brassica Oleracea var. Gemmifera</i>)	Biennial, annual. 2-3' and 1' wide.	7-12 Days	Indoors: 2-4 weeks before last frost
Cabbage (<i>Brassica Oleracea var Capitata</i>)	Biennial grown as an annual. 1-2' tall and 1-2' wide.	10-14 Days	Indoors: 2-4 weeks before last frost
Carrot (<i>Daucus Carota</i>)	Biennial grown as an annual with a rosette of leaves and a stout taproot.	14-21 Days	Indoors: 2-3 weeks before last frost
Cauliflower (<i>Brassica Oleracea var. botrytis</i>)	Annual plants that reach about 1.5' tall A	8-10 Days	Indoors: April
Collards (<i>Brassica Oleracea Var Vividas</i>)	An upright stalk, often growing 2-6' tall.	5-10 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost
Corn (<i>Zea mays</i>)	Annual cereal grass. Grows 5-12'.	18-21 Days	Indoors: 2 weeks before last frost
Cucumber (<i>Cucumis Sativus</i>)	Annual climbing vine. Grows 8-18" high and 3-8' wide.	3-10 Days	Indoor: Late April
Eggplant (<i>Solanum Melongena</i>)	Tender perennial grown as an annual, 2-4'	7-14 Days	Indoors: 8-10 Weeks before last frost
Jalapeno Pepper (<i>Capsicum Annuum</i>)	Annual, 3' and 24" wide.	14-21 Days	Indoors: 10 Weeks before last frost
Kale (<i>Brassica Oleracea</i>)	Annual plant, 3' in height.	6-12 Days	Indoors: 6 weeks before last frost
Kohlrabi (<i>Brassica Oleracea Gongylodes Group</i>)	Biennial vegetable, 12" tall and as wide.	7-10 Days	Indoors: Early April
Lettuce (<i>Lactuca Sativa</i>)	Annual, 12-40"	7-15 Days	Indoors: Any season
Okra (<i>Abelmoschus Esculentus</i>)	Perennial, often cultivated as an annual, 6 ft 7".	12-14 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost

Common Name	Description	Germination	When to Plant
Onion (<i>Allium Cepa</i>)	Annual, 6 to 18".	7-10 Days	Indoors: March or February
Peas (<i>Pisum sativum</i>)	Annual, 12-18". tall, 6-12" wide.	6-17 Days	Indoors: Late January to March
Pepper (<i>Capsicum Annum</i>)	Perennial, grown as an annual 12"-4'.	7-21 Days	Indoors: 8-10 weeks before last frost
Radish (<i>Raphinus Sativus</i>)	Annual, 6-8".	5-10 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost
Spinach (<i>Spinacia Oleracea</i>)	A hardy annual, 8-12".	5 Days	Indoors: 6 weeks before last frost
Squash (<i>Cucurbita Pepo</i>)	Annual, 1- 3' in height and 3-10'.	7-10 Days	Indoors: 4-6 weeks before last frost
Swiss Chard (<i>Beta Vulgaris</i>)	Biennial, at a height of 20" with an 18-20" spread.	7-14 Days	Indoors: 4 weeks before last frost
Tomato (<i>Solanum Melongena</i>)	Annual, 3-10'.	5-10 Days	Indoors: 6 weeks before last frost
Turnip (<i>Brassica Rapa Subsp Rapa</i>)	Biennial grown as an annual, 10-18".	4-7 Days	Indoors: 4-5 weeks before last frost
Zucchini (<i>Cucurbita Pepo</i>)	Annual, can reach 24".	7-14 Days	Indoors: late Winter-early Spring
